Dyer County Legacy: Great Migration

McIver's Grant was so pleased to collaborate with the Dyer County Historical Society in order to explore the local experience of the Great Migration on Tuesday, February 5th at 5pm. Panelists Dan Burch, Carolyn Smith Goings, Larry Williams and McIver's Grant board member Emma Fields shared their family stories and personal analysis behind the national movement of 6 million African-Americans from 1910 to 1970 out of the Southern United States.
